As a collective group of dedicated volunteers, the Harmony Foundation International (HFI) Board of Trustees remains grateful for the opportunity to serve our donors by remaining true to our mission to enrich lives through singing. We will continue to proudly perform our fiduciary duties to faithfully steward and protect the assets our donors have entrusted to us, while seeking the most impactful programs for financial support. Fiscal Year 2020 was a challenge for barbershop, the entire singing community, and HFI. The rise of COVID 10. PHS/s attempted hostile talkenyer of HFI. and the loss of collection of HFI. of COVID-19, BHS's attempted hostile takeover of HFI, and the loss of valuable programs that have been the focal point of HFI's past support stole from us much of what we hold dear. However, 2020 was not a total loss for HFI, as new and exciting opportunities arose.

During fiscal year 2020, HFI strengthened our partnership with the Association of International Champions (AIC) and launched the AIC Outreach Program, which seeks to provide financial Cnampions (AIC) and launched the AIC Outreach Program, which seeks to provide financial support to Chapters and Districts for programming and educational events that utilize the talents and expertise of AIC quartets within their regions. We kicked off fundraising for the program with a live-stream, virtual AIC Show in July of 2020, and nearly 30,000 sets of eyes around the world experienced a fantastic production. HFI is thrilled with the opportunity to fulfill our mission through this growing relationship with the AIC.

In addition, with help from the Wenk Family Foundation in Cleveland, OH, HFI partnered with the Men of Independence barbershop chorus to launch the Power of Harmony program, which seeks to change the lives of incarcerated youth through singing. The four pillars of the program include performance, education, participation, and mentorship after they are released. Our goal is to give these young people the change to change the trajectory of their lives by introducing them to give these young people the chance to change the trajectory of their lives by introducing them to music, and providing a community of support on the outside that may help them avoid the kinds of activities that led them down the wrong path in the first place.

Finally, after receiving communication from the Barbershop Harmony Society (BHS) HQ that prohibited HFI from using BHS HQ programs for fundraising purposes, HFI sought ways to support barbershop singing and programming on a local and regional level by partnering directly with the 16 US Districts of BHS, knowing the greatest impact members of BHS can make is within their own communities through their Chapters and Districts. We continue to work with Districts. their own communities through their Chapters and Districts. We continue to work with District leadership to identify and develop life-changing singing programs that will not only have benefits locally, but also provide growth and deep purpose to our barbershop singing communities across the country.




HFI raises voices through:
